POLLING SITES

- Members of the media are not allowed in the polling room except to vote while the polls are open and to observe setup before the polls open and after the polls close. (F.S. 102.031)
- No photography is permitted in the polling room or early voting area, except for a voter photographing their ballot. (F.S. 102.031)
- Election Workers are instructed to decline interviews and refer media to the Elections Office.

EXIT POLLING

- Exit polling is permitted inside the 150 ft no solicitation zone if it is conducted in an area that does not interfere with voter access to the polling place. (F.S. 102.031)
- If you plan to conduct an exit poll, please contact our office ahead of time so that we may better assist you and provide notice to our election workers.

TRACKING VOTER TURNOUT

- Voter turnout can be viewed as early as 45 days prior to an election at www.VoteMarion.Gov/Turnout and is updated every 10 minutes.
- Voter turnout includes ballots cast, not votes counted.

ELECTION RESULTS

- Local election results can be viewed at www.VoteMarion.gov/ElectionResults or from our media room on Election Night. Statewide election results can be viewed at Florida Election Watch.gov.
- Our first set of unofficial election results will be posted by 7:30 p.m. and updated every 15 minutes thereafter until all precincts are reported.
- Preliminary results include vote-by-mail and early voting totals followed by Election Day precinct
- Results are unofficial until the final Canvassing Board meets and certifies the election.
