Supervisor of Elections High School Registration Challenge

The Marion County Supervisor of Elections office announces Their 2019 Annual High School Registration Challenge to register and pre-register eligible students to vote.

Marion County, FL. February 1- The Marion County Supervisor of Elections office announces their 2019 Annual High School Registration Challenge that will begin February 1, 2019 and end May 1, 2019. Last year's program was the most successful ever, reaching 3,000 seniors and adding 736 eligible students to Marion County's voter rolls, a 479% increase from prior years. All Marion County's Public High Schools participated in last year's challenge and are supporting our efforts again this year.

Nonpartisan representatives from the Supervisor of Elections office will visit each school as scheduled to provide a voter registration activity of the school's choice to pre-register and register eligible students 16 years of age and older. Activities include presentations on the importance of voting, homecoming and student government mock elections, and lunchroom registration drives.

The winner will be determined by the number of new valid voter registrations based on the percentage of eligible students enrolled in the school and will receive a traveling trophy and name on a plaque displayed in our office.
