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## SPECIAL DISTRICT CANDIDATE INFORMATION

### QUALIFYING METHODS

There are 2 ways a Special District candidate can qualify: [Petition Method](#) OR [Pay the Qualifying Fee](#)

#### Petition Method

The candidate must submit 25 valid petitions **on or before Noon, May 18, 2020**.

You may begin collecting petition signatures and submitting them to the Elections Center **any time prior to the Noon, May 18, 2020 deadline**.

Pursuant to Florida Statute 99.097, a cost of .10¢ for each petition verified shall be paid in advance to the Supervisor of Elections unless an oath stating that such charges impose an undue burden on their personal resources.

#### Qualifying Fee

In lieu of the petition method, the candidate may pay a \$25.00 qualifying fee during the official qualifying period.

### OFFICIAL QUALIFYING PERIOD

To be a qualified candidate, all candidates must complete and submit qualifying papers during the Official Qualifying Period: **Noon, June 15, 2020 through Noon, June 19, 2020**.

Per Florida Statute, the qualifying officer may begin accepting and holding qualifying papers 2 weeks prior to qualifying – **June 1, 2020**. We request that you call the Election Center at 620-3290 ext. 220 to schedule a qualifying appointment.

### QUALIFYING DOCUMENTS

Special District candidates are required to file the following documents during the official qualifying period:

1. Statement of Financial Interests, Form 1 2019
2. Candidate Oath, DS-DE 302NP
3. Nickname Affidavit (if applicable).
4. Affidavit of Intent
5. Petition Certification or Pay the Qualifying Fee
