FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE

In Primary Elections, voters registered with no party affiliation (NPA) are not eligible to vote for political party candidates. Only voters who are registered members of political parties may vote for respective party candidates or nominees in the primaries, unless a Universal Primary Contest (UPC) occurs. There are two UPC contests in the Marion County, FL Primary Election: State Representative District 20 and County Commissioner District 1.
