## **Marion County November 8 General Election Update**

**Marion County, FL. October 25 -** Marion County Supervisor of Elections Wesley Wilcox reminds Marion County citizens of their voting options ahead of the November 8, 2022 General Election.

The deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot to be mailed for the General Election is October 29 by 5 p.m. Requests can be made by visiting <a href="https://www.VoteMarion.Gov">www.VoteMarion.Gov</a>, calling 352-620-3290, or in person at the Supervisor of Elections office. Mail ballots must be signed by the voter and received by the Elections Office by 7 p.m. Election Day to be counted.

The USPS encourages voters to mail their ballot at least a week prior to Election Day to ensure timely receipt. Alternatively, mail ballots can be returned to a Secure Ballot Intake Station at the Elections Office, M-F, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. or at any open Early Voting site during Early Voting hours.

Voters can check their mail ballot status by visiting <a href="www.VoteMarion.Gov">www.VoteMarion.Gov</a> and are encouraged to sign up for email, SMS (text), or voice mail ballot status alerts at <a href="www.MarionBallotTrax.com">www.MarionBallotTrax.com</a>.

Early Voting in Marion County begins Thursday, October 27 and will continue through Saturday, November 5 at nine Early Voting sites open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. at the following locations:

Voters are required to present a current and valid photo and signature identification to vote.
