## FILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORM 7:

**WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE:** By July 1, 1992. Officials who file Form 6, Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interests, should file this form with their Form 6 with the Department of State, Division of Elections, Room 1801, The Capitol, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0250. Officials who file Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, should file this form with their Form 1 with the Supervisor of Elections of the county where they reside.

**WHO MUST FILE:** Each person holding an *elective* State, county, district, or municipal office in Florida, and each appointed public officer who is required by law to file Form 6, Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interests, *except Judges*.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING FORM 7:

### INTRODUCTORY INFORMATION (At the Top of the Form):

**NAME OF AGENCY:** This should be the name of the governmental unit which you serve or served. For example, "City of Tallahassee," or "Florida Senate."

**OFFICE HELD:** Use the title of the office you hold or held during 1991 (in some cases you may not hold that position now, but you still would be required to file to disclose gifts and other contributions received during the last year you held that position). For example, "County Commissioner," or "Member."

**ADDRESS OF REPORTING INDIVIDUALS:** The following persons should *not* use their home addresses: active or former law enforcement personnel; firefighters; and personnel of D.H.R.S. whose duties include the investigation of abuse, neglect, exploitation, fraud, theft, or other criminal activities.

### PART A — STATEMENT OF GIFTS, DONATIONS, OR PAYMENTS [Sec. 112.3148, F.S. (1989), as amended by Ch. 90-502, LoF.]

Most gifts that were received during 1991 should be reported on CE Form 9, Quarterly Client Disclosure, or CE Form 10, Annual Disclosure of Gifts from Governmental Entities and Direct-Support Organizations and Honorarium Event Related Expenses.

This part should be used to report only "contributions" (defined to include any gift, donation, or payment) valued in excess of \$100 that were received after January 1, 1991 pursuant to an agreement entered into prior to that date. This *includes* any "contributions" that were received by you or on your behalf and includes any payment in excess of \$100 to a dinner, barbeque, fish fry, or other such event. *Excluded* are: campaign contributions (they are reportable under the campaign finance laws of Ch. 106, Fla. Stat.); gifts representing an expression of sympathy and having no material benefit; bona fide gifts for personal use from your parents, children, grandparents, grandchildren, brothers, sisters, uncles, aunts, nephews, nieces, great-grandparents and great-grandchildren; and honorary membership in social, service, or fraternal organizations presented as a courtesy by such organizations. Legislators also need not disclose complimentary parking privileges provided by an airport authority.
